the Pennines

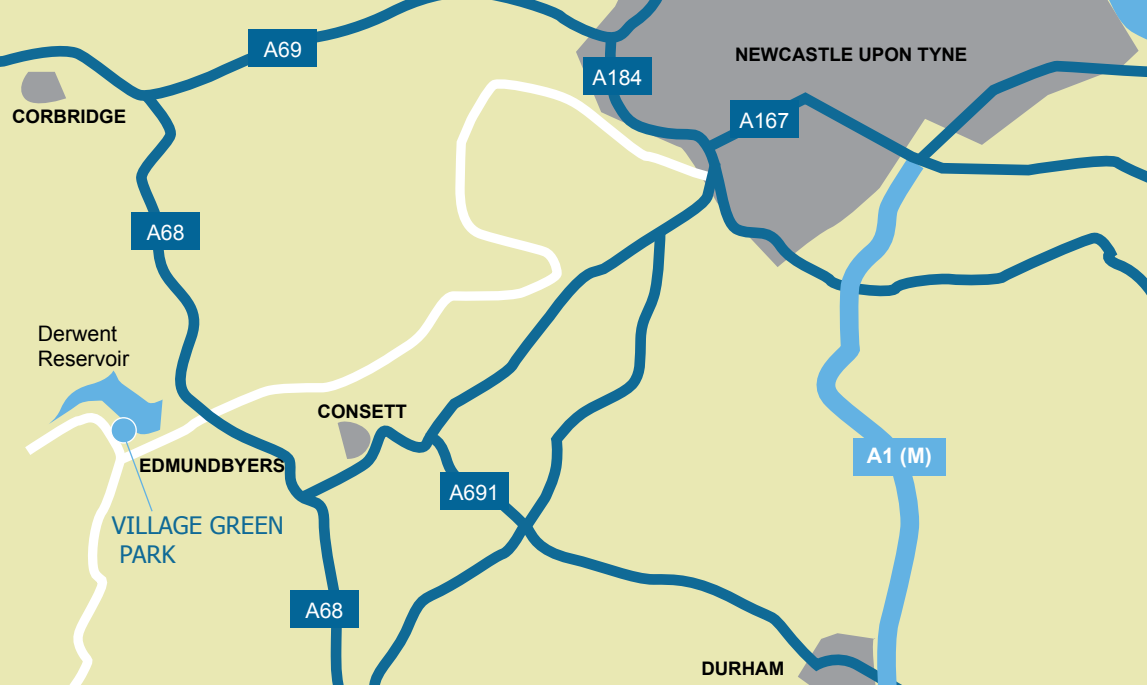

Take the A68 north from Consett towards Corbridge, after 4 miles take the left turn towards Edmundbyers. After entering the village, turn right, then after 50 metres turn right again onto a gravel road before the large green. Follow the road through the stone gate pillars and then bear right to reach the park.

Village Green is open from the 1st March until the 5th January each year. The fees for 2008 are £1500, including VAT and rates
